

**CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE CAMPING CARD INTERNATIONAL (CCI)**

- 1) The Camping Card International (CCI) is regarded as a camper's identity document and may be deposited with the campsite manager in lieu of your official identity document (passport).
- 2) All CCI-holders should abide by the attached Camper's Code.
- 3) Do not forget to produce your CCI upon arrival. On some sites, CCI holders are entitled to a discount on regular fees.
- 4) The period of validity appears on the CCI. The CCI is proof that the liability of the holder and accompanying party is covered in case of bodily injury or material damage caused to a third party, in accordance with the terms described overleaf.
- 5) In the event of a claim made against you or your party for damage caused to a third party, you must immediately notify the issuing club or association, give full details of the circumstances, and if possible provide witness evidence.
- 6) Take care of your Camping Card, as you may be liable for fees incurred through its misuse.

**CAMPER'S CODE**

- a) Camp only at campsites that are permanently authorised or where permission is given on request (particularly in forests). Give your Camping Card to the manager to keep during the period of your stay. Follow the camp regulations and those of the local authority.
- b) Do not light a wood fire without permission; do not cause damage to hedges or trees by fire. Before lighting a fire, clear the site of brushwood.
- c) Do not leave any rubbish on the campsite. Dispose of it in accordance with the camp rules; if there are no facilities for rubbish disposal, take it away. Always leave the site as clean when you depart as you would like to find it when you come again.
- d) Pay special attention to questions of sanitation. Be polite. Respect other people's peace and property and do not shock them by your language or by your dress.
- e) Do not disturb the silent hours as published on the site.

## F.I.C.C. CAMPERS' THIRD PARTY INSURANCE (2004) - SUMMARY OF COVER

Please note that this is just a summary of the cover provided. On request a copy of the full text which will be used in the event of any dispute is available for your inspection ..

Your Club's policy indemnifies third parties up to € 1.650.000 (CHF 2'500'000) for claims made against you following an accident in respect of Bodily Injury or Disease and Damage to Property caused by you or any person travelling with you in the same private vehicle (maximum 11 passengers) whilst camping away from home or staying in rented accommodation or at a hotel. Coverage is world-wide but excludes USA and Canada jurisdiction.

If you have to leave your party behind temporarily whilst returning home during the course of the holiday, the members of your party will continue to be covered.

### **EXCLUSIONS: Your Club's policy does not cover:**

1. Accidents caused by: mechanically propelled vehicles; ships, boats (except windsurfers and unpowered boats under 5 metres in length) or aircraft; food or drink poisoning; pollution of air, water or soil; the organisation of any form of large scale entertainment where an entry fee is charged; damage to ground or crops caused by trampling or setting up tents; indiscriminate disposal of garbage; damage to underground water, gas or electricity pipes or cables, and any act committed with malicious intent.
2. Accidents happening through or in consequence of war, invasion, acts of foreign enemy, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection or military or usurped power or confiscation, nationalisation, requisition, destruction of or damage to property by or under the order of any Government, Republic or Local Authority.
3. Bodily injury or disease or damage to property sustained by any person arising out of and in the course of his employment by the Camping Card holder under a contract of service or apprenticeship with the Camping Card holder.
4. Damage to property owned or occupied by or in the care, custody or control of an Assured.

This policy is also subject to a "Radioactive Contamination and Explosive Nuclear Assemblies Exclusion" Clause and an "Asbestos Exclusion" Clause.

### **CLAIMS:**

In the event of a claim being made against you, you must notify your Club immediately in writing, providing full particulars of the incident and details of other third party insurances held. Do not admit liability for or offer, or agree, to settle any claim without the written consent of your Club. Underwriters insuring your Club shall be entitled to take over and conduct in your name any claims against any third party and shall have full discretion in the conduct of any negotiations, proceedings and the settlement of any claim. You must give to the Underwriters such information and assistance as they may reasonably require. Claims arising whilst staying in rented accommodation or at a hotel are subject to an excess of € 65.00 or equivalent in other currencies.

### **FRAUDULENT CLAIMS AND OTHER INSURANCE:**

If any insured person shall make any claim knowing the same to be false or fraudulent as regards amount or otherwise, the cover under this policy shall become void and all claim for indemnity by that person shall be forfeited.

If an accident is also covered by another insurance, the liability of the Underwriters shall be limited to the proportion of such claim which is not covered elsewhere.
